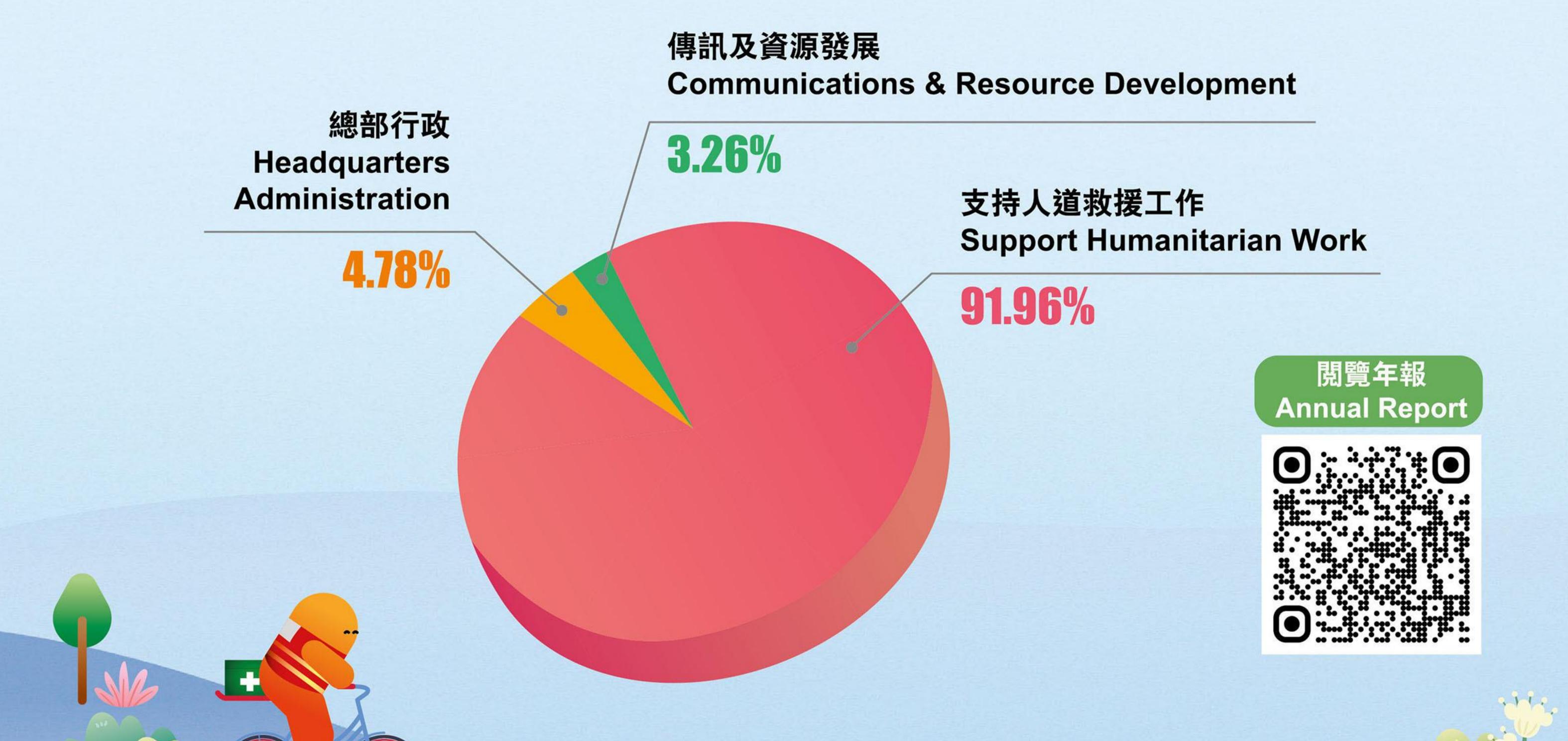

緊急救援及備災

Emergency Relief and Disaster Preparedness

為受危難事故影響的人士提供適切的人道救援服務,與及提升社區應對危難事故的能力及意識。

Provide appropriate humanitarian assistance to people who are affected by crises and raise the community's awareness and ability to respond.

人道救援無遠弗屆

Far-Reaching Humanitarian Aid

疫情持續兩年多,帶來廣泛影響,我們為本地有需要人士提供即時緊急支援;包括物資、心理支援等。同時,世界一些國家亦同時面對天災、衝突及疫情帶來的危機。受氣候變化影響,極端天氣事件越趨頻繁,加劇各地災情。我們積極行動,回應全球不同地方的人道需求,包括提供糧食、乾淨食水、衞生設施、臨時居所,緊急醫療服務及心理支援服務等人道援助,持續支持災害多發的地區進行災後恢復重建及備災減災的工作。

The pandemic has lasted for more than two years, affecting many, we have provided local emergency support including supplies and psychological support to those in need. At the same time, some countries are facing multiple crises caused by natural disasters, conflicts, and the pandemic. Also, affected by climate change, extreme weather events are becoming



more frequent and exacerbating disasters impact everywhere. We take proactive actions to respond to the humanitarian needs of different places in the world. We provide humanitarian assistance including the provision of food, clean water, hygiene facilities, temporary shelter, medical care, and psychological support, and continue to support the development of disaster-prone areas on post-disaster recovery and reconstruction, as well as disaster preparedness and risk reduction programmes.



備災有道你我做到

Everyone Has A Role In Disaster Preparedness

災害難以完全避免,但只要及早準備,便能將人命傷亡及財產損失減至最低。我們致力為不同社群 提供備災訓練,透過工作坊、流動防災教育車、災難虛擬實境遊戲等,提升市民應對危難事故的知識 及能力。因應颱風、水浸、火災等常見災害,我們會到高危地區進行家居探訪及工作坊,了解居民 需要,為他們提供防災知識和物資。

Although disasters might not be totally avoidable, we can take the initiative to get prepared for disasters, and hence reduce casualties and property losses. We are committed to providing disaster preparedness training for different communities. Also, we strive to enhance the knowledge and ability of the public to cope with emergencies through workshops, moving disaster preparedness education trucks, and virtual reality games. In response to common disasters, such as typhoons, floods, and fire, we conducted home visits and workshops in high-risk areas, to understand the needs of residents and provide them with disaster prevention knowledge and materials.

社區健康服務及教育

Community Health Service and Education

關懷本地有需要社群,加強社會人士對健康及急救的認識,共建關愛及健康的社區。

Care about local people in need and enhance public understanding of health and first aid to build a caring and healthy community.

多元服務以應需求

Response to the Needs with Diverse Services

因應疫情發展,我們推出「器材到戶服務」,將輔助行動器材直接送到服務使用者住處或指定地點,減低服務使用者或照顧者外出感染病毒的風險,並豁免低收入獨居/雙老戶長者、傷病者或其照顧者的器材運費及部份租金,以減輕他們的經濟負擔。

In response to the evolving pandemic situation, we launched a door-to-door delivery service to send equipment directly to service users' homes or designated locations, keeping service users and caretakers safe from the virus. Also, we exempted the delivery fee and part of the rental fee for low-income elder singletons, doubletons, the sick, the injured, and their caregivers to reduce their financial burden.





急救為人人人學急救

First Aid for All

我們致力推廣「普及急救」,開辦不同類型的訓練課程,讓市民掌握急救知識和技術,在緊急情況時 救人自救。更舉辦多項宣傳活動,如以實體及線上混合模式,示範心肺復蘇法及去顫法;及透過微電影, 向大眾展示學習使用自動體外心臟去纖維性顫動器的重要性。

Committed to promoting the principle of "First Aid for All", we have been running different kinds of training courses, enabling the public to acquire knowledge and skills of first aid and to help themselves and others in emergencies. We also conducted different promotional activities, such as demonstrating the steps of Cardio-pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) in hybrid mode; and broadcasted microfilm to promote the importance of acquiring knowledge on using AED.

特殊教育及復康

Special Education and Rehabilitation

為有特殊教育需要人士提供教育、復康及住宿服務,實踐維護尊嚴的精神。

Take care of people with special education needs and provide them with education, rehabilitation, and boarding services to put the spirit of respecting human dignity into practice.

多元探索擴闊視野

Diversified Exploration Broadens Horizons

疫情下,我們轄下四所特殊學校活動仍然多姿多彩,如添置網上圖書館系統,讓學生即使身在病榻,也可以隨時隨地借閱圖書,培養閱讀好習慣;參與校外不同比賽及在疫情稍緩時進行戶外體驗活動,讓學生突破肢體障礙的限制,啟發潛能;善用虛擬實體技術進行虛擬境外考察,體驗不同國家及地區的文化,全方位學習,擴闊視野。

Under the pandemic, exciting activities were still offered by the four special schools under the HKRC. Such as introducing online library systems, even when students are bedridden, they can borrow books anytime anywhere, thereby cultivating good reading habits; participating in off-campus competitions and outdoor activities when the pandemic improves, breaking through the limitations of physical disabilities to unleash potential; applying virtual reality technology to arrange virtual overseas tours for students, to experience the history and culture of different countries and regions to achieve life-wide learning and broaden horizons.





教育活動繼續精彩

Fabulous Educational Activities Keep Going

首支智障人士紅十字制服隊伍成立。經過兩年訓練,12位順利宿舍舍友正式宣誓,組成 紅十字成人團第33團。舍友們透過各項訓練,包括學習紅十字知識、健康知識和步操 訓練等,提升自主能力和自信。團員會繼續接受各類型領袖培訓及參與義務工作,學習 人道精神。

The first Red Cross Youth Uniformed Unit consisting of mentally handicapped persons was established. After two years of training, 12 residents from the Shun Lee Hostel made an oath to form the Red Cross Youth Adult Unit 33. Through various training, residents acquired knowledge about the Red Cross, healthcare, and marching, increasing their autonomy and confidence. Members will continue to receive a variety of leadership training and participate in voluntary work to learn about humanitarian values.

人道參與及教育

Humanitarian Engagement and Education

透過不同活動及計劃向大眾宣揚人道價值,讓更多人認識及參與人道工作。

Through a wide range of activities, we raise public awareness of humanitarian values, getting more people to take part in humanitarian initiatives.

培育青年探索自我

Nurturing Young People Through Self-Exploration

我們鼓勵青年人探索自我,由自身開始,帶動朋輩參與,持續貢獻社區。如「Made In Youth — 社區友伙服務領袖計劃」,青年人透過體驗式學習、價值觀探索活動、自主策劃社區服務及定期師友共學,以人道角度探索本地社區需要,設計服務計劃,改善弱勢社群處境。

We encourage young people to better understand themselves and actively invite their peers to jointly contribute to the community. Such as the "Made In Youth" Programme, in which young people explore the needs of the local community from a humanitarian perspective, and design service plans to improve situations of vulnerable groups through experiential learning, value exploration activities, self-planning community services, and regular mentorship activities.





人道教育推廣探索無間斷

Continually Promote and Explore of Humanitarian Value

疫情減少了大眾參與活動的機會,但無阻我們推廣人道教育。位於我們總部的人道教育中心內,題為「暗夜明燈」的主題資料館被數碼化,製成360度影像的虛擬展覽,並推出網上導賞服務。觀眾可透過屏幕,按自己的步伐點選各項展品進行探索;或由導賞員以輕鬆方法帶領參加者從人道視角認識世界,關心身處苦難的人。

Although the pandemic has reduced the opportunities for the public to join the activities, our promotion of humanitarian education never stops. The Red Cross Library with the theme of "Light the Darkness" located at our Headquarters has been digitalized and transformed into a 360-degree interactive virtual tour. Visitors can watch and explore the related humanitarian issues at their own pace by clicking the exhibits; or in the video guide tour, the docent introduces the exhibits and information to visitors, helping them understand the world from a humanitarian perspective and encouraging them to extend care for the suffering people.
